Operation Innoculation: Success



The Benton County Public Health nurses visited CLS last week and converted the conference room into a makeshift clinic. When it was all done, they vaccinated about half the student body.

Students 10 and younger will need a second dose of the vaccination, therefore a second clinic is scheduled **Friday, Dec. 11**. If your student received the shot the first time, he/she will likely get the shot the second time. Similarly, if he received the mist the first time, he will get the mist the second time. It will depend on the supply of vaccine available. You need not sign anymore consent forms for the second dose to be delivered.

If you missed the clinic and still would like your child vaccinated, or if you've changed your mind, please contact the BCPH and schedule an appointment. Their office is located across the street from the courthouse in Vinton. There is no charge for the vaccine. If you know of a pregnant woman who has not been vaccinated due to the short supply, please pass the word that BCPH has the vaccine and will vaccinate pregnant women regardless of which county they live in.
