

CLS REACH

The CLS REACH program (tRusted Education Allowing Christ-Centered enrichment) gives families new to Central Lutheran School (CLS) a waiver on their first year’s tuition. This one year tuition waiver allows a family the opportunity to discover why CLS is the school they want their child(ren) to be attending throughout their elementary and middle school years.

We are confident in our role of providing a Christ-centered, top quality educational program to all. We feel the CLS REACH program will give us the opportunity to share the message of Christ with more families.

The new families will be financially responsible for a registration deposit (\$340 per child) and additional costs not covered under tuition (i.e. lunch, field trips, extra-curricular activities).

Core Elements of the Program:

- The program is open to all interested new families with children in kindergarten to 7th grade.
- Students from CLS supporting congregations will be given priority; otherwise the program is on a space available first come basis.
- Enrollment will be done via an initial wait list and is dependent upon class availability.
- 8th grade is exempt, unless the student is a part of a family entering CLS with students in other grades. All students in the family must be new to CLS.
- CLS REACH families are expected to volunteer and participate in fundraisers and general donation campaigns, in order to fully encompass the CLS experience.
- All families will have a pre-enrollment interview with the principal. An application acceptance including previous school records and testing of students may be conducted as a screening method for determining academic readiness for grade level.
